

RWTH International Academy Student Project Grant Conditions and Regulations | 10 August 2021

Preamble

The "Student Project Grant" was established to support students who are enrolled in one of the following engineering Master of Science degree programs organized by RWTH International Academy. The grant can be awarded to RWTH International Academy students who wish to pursue field research, extracurricular research work, or project work (hereafter referred to as "project") during their degree program.

- (1) M. Sc. Computer Aided Conception and Production in Mechanical Engineering
- (2) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Computer Aided Mechanical Engineering
- (3) M. Sc. Networked Production Engineering
- (4) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Structural Engineering and Risk Management of Industrial Facilities
- (5) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Production Systems
- (6) M. Sc. Production Systems Engineering
- (7) M. Sc. Robotic Systems Engineering
- (8) M. Sc. Textile Engineering

§ 1 Principles

- (1) The proposed project work may not count towards any credit points for the students' studies.
- (2) The proposed project should generally have a minimum duration of one month.
- (3) The maximum total value of the grant is EUR 1,500.
- (4) The grant can be awarded twice a year.
- (5) Only one grant will be awarded to any one project.
- (6) The winners will be honored with a scholarship certificate from RWTH International Academy.

§ 2 Expected Qualification of the Students

Applicants must be enrolled in one of the Master's degree programs listed above offered by RWTH International Academy.

§ 3 Basis of the Evaluation

The basis of the evaluation is the student's project proposal and expenses plan.

§ 4 Time Frame for Applications

Students may apply for the grant from 15 May to 30 May and from 15 November to 30 November each year.

§ 5 Required Documents

Students have to submit the following documents as PDF files within the given deadline to the Online Application Portal:

- (1) A project proposal (max. 2 pages of coherent text)
- (2) A project plan (schematic illustration of your plan)
- (3) An expenses plan
- (4) A brief letter of motivation including career plans (one page)
- (5) A brief CV (one page)
- (6) A complete transcript of records provided by the RWTH Central Examination Office.



§ 6 Conditions of Funding

After completing the project, the grant holder agrees to present their project experience and provide the following documentation:

- (1) A written report (minimum 3 pages)
- (2) A testimonial for RWTH International Academy
- (3) An oral presentation for RWTH International Academy students
- (4) Further action might be considered on individual basis.

§ 7 Escape clause

The possibility to award this grant is dependent on the financial capital available in the RWTH International Academy students fund. There is no legal basis for students to claim this scholarship.
