RWTH International Academy Social Responsibility Award

Regulations | Effective as of 15th May 2024

Preamble

The Social Responsibility Award was established to honor deserving RWTH International Academy students who demonstrate their awareness and responsibility for our society and environment by regularly contributing to communal or creative commitments.

Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following degree programs:

- (1) M.Sc. Computer Aided Conception and Production in Mechanical Engineering
- (2) M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Computer Aided Mechanical Engineering
- (3) M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Production Systems
- (4) M.Sc. Networked Production Engineering
- (5) M.Sc. Production Systems Engineering
- (6) M.Sc. Robotic Systems Engineering
- (7) M.Sc. Smart Production Engineering
- (8) M.Sc. Textile Engineering
- (9) MPA European Studies
- (10) M.Sc. Resilient Civil Engineering

§ 1 Principles

- (1) The award may be granted to a maximum of three applicants per application period. If two applicants' performance is comparably good, the scholarship may be divided between them.
- (2) Awardees will be granted a reward of 1,000.00 € as well as an award certificate from RWTH International Academy. The reward will be transferred to the awardee's bank account. Awardees can only receive a payout of the scholarship payment if they do not have any liabilities with RWTH International Academy. If liabilities exist, the scholarship amount will be fully or partially settled with any outstanding amounts, depending on the individual case.

§ 2 Basis of evaluation

The basis of evaluation are the applicant's application documents detailing the applicant's social engagement and activities. After evaluating an applicant's profile, they may be invited to an interview with the Scholarship Committee.

§ 3 Application documents

A complete application consists of the following documents:

- (1) Letter of motivation (one page max.)
- (2) CV
- (3) A complete and up-to-date transcript of records (Notenspiegel)
- (4) Certificates and/or reference letters describing the applicant's social commitment.



§ 4 Application details

- (1) Applications must be submitted as pdf files through the **Online Application Portal**.
- (2) Students may apply for this award between 15 January and 30 January each year.
- (3) Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.
- (4) Applications submitted by means other than the application portal will not be considered.
- (5) Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applications will be evaluated after the respective application deadline. Students will be informed about the result by email.

§ 5 Conditions of funding

Awardees agree to provide a testimonial for RWTH International Academy and hold a presentation about their involvement to the student community.

§ 6 Escape clause

The possibility to award this grant is dependent on the financial capital available in RWTH International Academy's students fund. There is no legal basis for students to claim this scholarship.
