

# RWTH International Academy Student Project Grant

## Regulations | Effective as of 20 October 2022

### Preamble

The Student Project Grant was established to support and encourage RWTH International Academy students in their extracurricular field research, research work or project work (hereafter referred to as "project") during their degree program. Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following degree programs:

- (1) M. Sc. Computer Aided Conception and Production in Mechanical Engineering
- (2) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Computer Aided Mechanical Engineering
- (3) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Structural Engineering and Risk Management of Industrial Facilities
- (4) M. Sc. Networked Production Engineering
- (5) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Production Systems
- (6) M. Sc. Production Systems Engineering
- (7) M. Sc. Robotic Systems Engineering
- (8) M. Sc. Textile Engineering
- (9) MPA European Studies

### § 1 Principles

- (1) The Student Project Grant is open to students enrolled in one of the above-mentioned degree programs. Students are asked to submit only one application per project. They may apply as a group or as individuals.
- (2) The project must be extracurricular, i.e. not count towards the applicant's study requirements and should have a minimum duration of one month.
- (3) The Student Project Grant may be awarded to any one project only once.
- (4) The winning project will be funded with a maximum sum of 1,500.00 €. The respective winning applicants will receive an award certificate from RWTH International Academy.

### § 2 Basis of evaluation

The basis of evaluation are the applicant's application documents detailing the project.

### § 3 Required application documents

A complete application consists of the following documents:

- (1) Project proposal (max. 2 pages of coherent text)
- (2) Project plan (schematic illustration of the applicant's plan)
- (3) Expenses plan
- (4) Letter of motivation including career plans (one page max.)
- (5) CV
- (6) Complete and up-to-date transcript of records

#### § 4 Application details

- (1) Applications must be submitted as pdf files through the [online application portal](#).
- (2) Students may apply for this grant between 15 November and 30 November each year.
- (3) Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.
- (4) Applications submitted by means other than the application portal will not be considered.
- (5) Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applications will be evaluated after the respective application deadline. Students will be informed about the result by email.

#### § 5 Conditions of Funding

After completing the project, the grant holder agrees to present their project experience and provide the following documentation:

- (1) Project report
- (2) Project presentation to the RWTH International Academy student community
- (3) A testimonial for RWTH International Academy

#### § 6 Escape clause

The possibility to award this grant is dependent on the financial capital available in the RWTH International Academy students fund. There is no legal basis for students to claim this grant.
